


## Trail Etiquette

- Stop, look and listen for motor traffic before crossing
- ♦ Always stay to the right when riding, except to pass, where appropriate
- When appropriate, announce your presence with a bell or saying "on your left" when passing
- lacktriangle Have fun and keep the trails and routes pretty by taking care of your
- Obey traffic signs
- Be respectful and share the path
- Move off the trail or road when stopping
- ♦ Wear a bicycle helmet
- Always travel at a safe speed

## Trail Mileage between Community Trailheads

South terminus to Waters	1.6
Waters to Gaylord	10.4
Gaylord to Vanderbilt	8.4
Vanderbilt to Wolverine	10.8
Wolverine to Indian River	10.0
Indian River to Topinabee	5.4
Topinabee to Cheboygan	12.0
Cheboygan to Mackinaw City	16.3
Total Miles	74.9



## **North Central State Trail** Part of Michigan's Iron Belle Trail

A 75 mile multi-use trail con-necting Gaylord, Indian River, Cheboygan and Mackinaw City. The trail has a 10' wide packed crushed limestone surface and is open to all non-motorized uses year round.



Open to snowmobiles
December 1st to March 31st

## Notes:

The trail gradually drops 770' between Gaylord and Indian River.

Mile Markers use the histor-ic Michigan Central Railroad numbering from Bay City to Mackinaw. Mile Marker 121 is just north of Gaylord and Mile Marker 181 is south of Mackinaw City.

Cell phone signal coverage along the trail is limited.
